February 15, 2021

TREASURER REPORT Bonnie presented the treasurer's report. General fund balance: \$24,532.68 February 1 and \$24,725.18 at meeting date. Project fund: \$11,174.46.

CURRENT BUSINESS

1. Jim thanked everyone for coming reported there were no hours put into the NPR since last meeting.
2. Bonnie Smith has presented the proposal to Brian Heath for the work out stations. They met last week, but she has not heard back. She will contact Brian to find out progress.
3. We turned down for the present the option of making a dog park on Timothy Street due to neighbor concerns. We want the city to pursue the option of a dog park on Lincoln Street which was in the cities long-range plan.
4. The board of NCNA has endorsed the community garden proposed by Abbe Rippe.
5. It is not a community garden, but a design or education garden. Students to participate will be recruited from the North Cedar School. This now has to be presented to the City Council for the next steps.
6. Lorene Wellnitz was thanked for all her work to make Cedar Falls a bird friendly city. March 15 at City Hall the Trees Forever will present the certification. NCNA members are encouraged to go to the event.
7. Randy Hashman reported about the Summer Block Party with Gallagher Bluedorn has been set up at the Eagle's Club on August 27 from 7:00 to 9:00. We have the Stackhouse Band. We hope to encourage people to join the NCNA.
8. Mark Miller reported on the flood gates. Public works reports that the flood gates are cracked at present and that is the only thing that can be done at this time of year.
